

**Celebrate the arrival of  
the Three Kings with La Galette des Rois!**

**January 6-12, 2012**



**La galette des Rois (the cake or "wafer" of the Kings), is a cake that celebrates the Epiphany. The cake consists of flaky puff pastry layers with a dense center of frangipane.**

**Tradition holds that the cake is "to draw the kings" to the Epiphany. A figurine, "la fève", representing anything from a car to a cartoon character, is hidden in the cake and the person who finds la fève in their slice becomes king for the day.**

**Interesting Fact: The French President is not allowed to "draw the kings" on Epiphany because of the etiquette rules. Therefore, a traditional galette without figurine or crown is served at Elysée Palace in January.**
